Thank you for building your Statutory Declaration on our law firm's website.

To be valid your Statutory Declaration must be:

- a) In the correct form; and
- b) Signed in front of the prescribed person – usually a JP, public servant or pharmacist

You must sign your Statutory Declaration **in front** of the Justice of the Peace or other prescribed person – 'statutory declarations and affidavits must be signed in the presence of the person witnessing them'.

### **Statutory Declaration 2 or more pages?**

If your Statutory Declaration goes over one page then your JP will get you to sign each and every page on the Statutory Declaration. Including the first page. Your JP also signs every page.

### **Are you under 18 years of age?**

If you, as someone under 18 years of age, can understand the nature and meaning of the Statutory Declaration your JP may be happy to witness the Statutory Declaration. Otherwise, your parents or guardians may make the declaration on your behalf.

### **Are you blind or illiterate?**

If you are blind, illiterate or unable to read the declaration, your JP will:

- a) Read the Statutory Declaration in your presence;
- b) Ask if you understand it;
- c) Ask you to sign or make your mark in the JP's presence.

The JP adds the following text under your signature at the end of the declaration:

The declarant being (blind OR illiterate OR unable to read) and the contents of this declaration having first been read over to the declarant and the declarant appearing to understand the nature and the effect of the Statutory Declaration.

### **Interstate Statutory Declarations**

JPs are authorised under the *Commonwealth Statutory Declarations Act Regulations* to witness a Statutory Declaration made within any Australian Jurisdiction.
